

Community Center Director Report – June 12, 2018

The Bethlehem Township Community Center (BTCC) welcomed the summer of 2018 with a flurry of fun filled activities and events over the last month. The Kid's Triathlon was conducted on Sunday, June 3rd. Although the weather wasn't favorable with cooler temps and slight drizzles, nearly 50 future swimmers, runners, and bikers participated in the successful family event. Camp Groundhog (BTCC's full day camp) began on Monday, June 11th with a full roster of 60 children and 13 children in our mini camp program for children 3-5 years old. The Summer Playground Program is set to begin Monday, June 28th. We have close to 475 children registered for the 8 week season. Participants utilize Comer Park, Chetwyn Park, and Municipal Park as well as attend several field trips throughout the summer.

BTCC's outdoor pool opened on Saturday, May 26th with a seemingly slow start to summer. Rain and colder temperatures have kept the pool closed on several occasions. The outdoor pool complex is now open to the public daily from noon to 8:00pm (weather permitting). The indoor pool was no stranger to crowds as the Blue Sharks swim team began practice on Monday, June 11th and swim lessons scheduled to begin on Monday, June 18th.
