

Community Center Director Report – September 12, 2017

The Bethlehem Township Community Center (BTCC) officially closed its doors to summer 2017! The Labor Day Holiday weekend had less than desirable swimming weather, resulting in pool closures on 2 of the 3 days. Although we said goodbye to summer, the outdoor pool lap lanes have remained open for our dedicated lap swimmers and personal water workout members. With slightly condensed hours from our inside building, this gives our members an alternative place to swim with the renovations on the natatorium.

The pool heater is currently in the process of being installed, which will allow us to keep the pool open longer into the Fall season.
