MANPOWER REPORT:

A supervisor was injured while off duty and required the surgical repair of a damaged shoulder. The date for his return to duty is not yet known.

TRAINING:

- Corporal Powell continues training with the *Northwestern University School of Police Staff and Command* and will complete training in February 2018.
- Officers Knouss and Frantz completed a two-day recertification course in '*Motor Carrier Enforcement Updates*'.
- Corporal Anderson and Investigator Fox completed a two-day course entitled '*Courtroom Testimony in Narcotic Cases*'.
- All officers are completing two days of state mandated courses at the Allentown Police Academy or on-line.

ARRESTS & INVESTIGATIONS:

- A township resident fired several shots from a handgun at his wife after which she was able to escape the residence unharmed. A nine hour standoff ensued and ended when the Pennsylvania State Police SERT Team forcibly entered the residence and took the suspect into custody. Township officers received critical support from officers of the Palmer Township Police Department, PA State Police and EMS.
