MANPOWER REPORT:

- In March, 2018 a patrol officer was injured after being struck by a vehicle which failed to stop at a stop sign, striking the officer who was directing traffic. The officer is undergoing therapy for his injuries and has been assigned to light duty status.
- An officer was injured in an off-duty accident had returned to active duty, but then required a medical procedure and will be returning to light-duty status shortly.
- Adam Ebner has started his patrol officer training at the Allentown Police Academy and will complete the training in June.
- Officer Malkin has completed his training with an FTO (Field Training Officer) and has been assigned to a patrol function.

TRAINING:

- Officers Knouss and Frantz completed two days of MCSE update training (Commercial Vehicle Inspections).
- Officers Williams and Malkin completed a two day training course entitled 'Street Cops: Proactive Patrol'.
- Officers have begun to attend the annual mandatory two days of training at the Allentown Police Academy.

ARRESTS & INVESTIGATIONS:

- An employee at the Geodis warehouse located at Township Line and Brodhead Roads has been incarcerated after threatening other employees with a weapon after his employment at the warehouse was terminated.
- An unidentified subject phoned in a report of an active shooter inside of a home located at Washington & Juniper Sts., a residential neighborhood. Officers were able to quickly determine the call to be a hoax and the investigation is continuing to identify the caller.
- ***OTHER INFORMATION:***
- Nicole Ramsey, who had been struck by a vehicle while standing in a parking lot off of Turner St. near 9th in August of 2018, died on January 21st as a result of her injuries.
