

Community Center Director Report – June 13, 2022

The Bethlehem Township Community Center (BTCC) welcomed the summer of 2022 with a flurry of fun filled activities and events. Camp Groundhog (BTCC's full day camp) began on Monday, June 13th with a full roster of 60 children. The Summer Playground Program is set to begin Monday, June 20th.
