MANPOWER REPORT:

- The Bethlehem Township Civil Service Commission met to certify the list of candidates eligible for hire as a patrol officer. A recommendation was forwarded to the Board of Commissioners for two of the candidates to be conditionally hired.
- A patrol officer who underwent a surgical procedure for an off-duty injury has returned to full, active duty.

TRAINING:

- Sgt. LaPointe and Officer Frantz completed a 3-day course of instruction to be recertified to conduct ***Vehicular Accident Reconstructions***.
- Corporal Anderson completed a 3-day course in ***Dark Web Cyber Investigations***.
- Police Clerk Swartz attended a one-day course of instruction regarding the ***Pennsylvania Summary Reporting System***.
- Sgt. Powell conducted a presentation for the Northampton County CIT course relative to ***Project Lifesaver*** and disorders that cause wandering.
- Investigator Stevens conducted a presentation for the Northampton County Community College Criminal Justice Club in conjunction with the Crime Victim's Council.

ARRESTS & INVESTIGATIONS:

- An Easton adult male was arrested for the rape/statutory sexual assault of an underage female after both attended a party which included the consumption of alcohol by minors.
- A man was charged with the attempted strangulation of his wife after an hours long standoff on Milan St. in Madison Farms. Officer Stanton and Investigator Fix negotiated the peaceful surrender of the suspect.
- A female victim reported that she was sexually assaulted at a township party. A suspect has been identified and the investigation is ongoing.
